### *VALE ROSE MORROW*

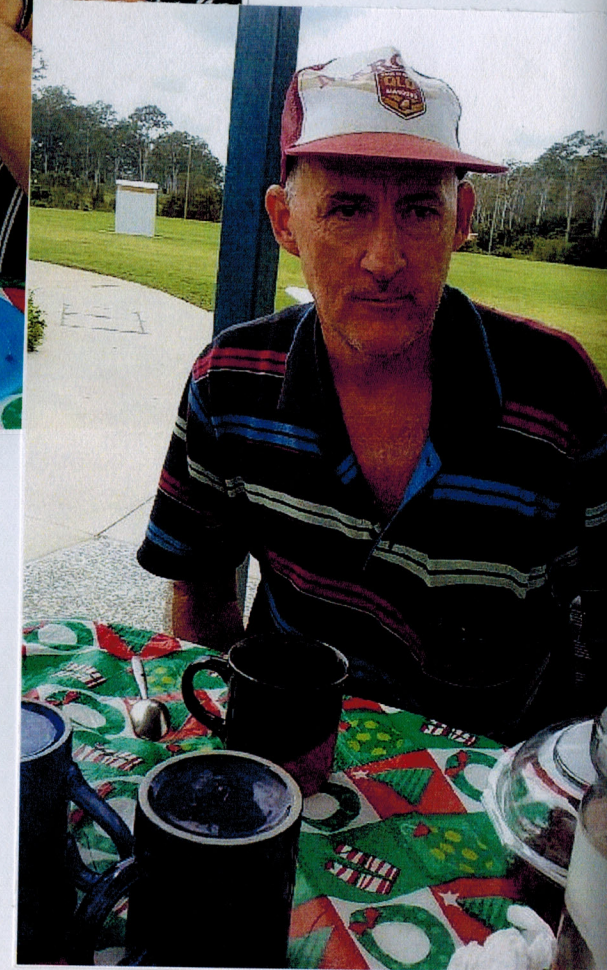

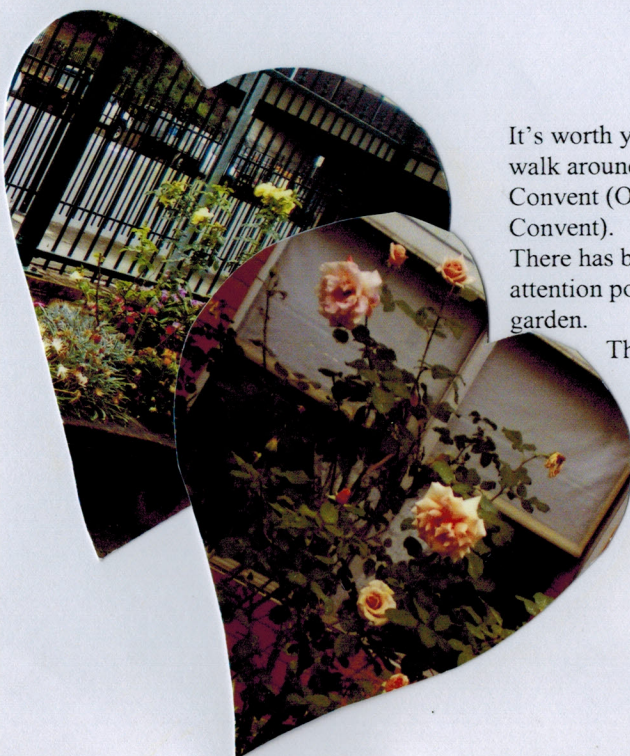
